

Installing Allworx Reach for Android

Android app package kit (APK) is a file format used to install apps on Android devices. To install Allworx Reach for Android, you must download the APK file from Allworx and open it on your Android device. Perform the following steps:

- 1. On your Android device, change the setting that enables you to install apps from sources other than the Google Play Store. The location and name of the setting varies among different Android versions and device manufacturers. Open the Settings app and search for "unknown sources" or "unknown apps". Navigate to the setting and enable it.
- 2. Download the Reach APK file from Allworx at https://get.allworx.com/reach/
- 3. To install the application, open your Android device's file manager app and locate the APK file. The file manager is usually called Files, My Files, or File Browser, and you'll typically find it in the app drawer. The APK file should be in the Downloads folder.
- 4. Tap on the Allworx Reach APK file. It will ask if you want to install the app. Confirm and proceed. Once finished, tap the Done button. Reach is ready to configure and use.
